We are pleased to announce that CMP's paint has been applied to the Main Bridge of Nhat Tan Bridge (Vietnam-Japan Friendship Bridge) which opened on 4th January, 2015. This Main Bridge is the biggest continuous cable-stayed bridge in south-eastern Asia.

Our product, "FLUOREX", recently applied as the over coating for the Main Bridge, has been developed based on fluororesin and has an excellent weathering, chemical and water resistant property. FLUOREX has also been applied to many other projects in the past, and users can expect lowering life cycle cost for structures.

CMP will continue to put the Group's overall effort to expand sales of industrial paint both in and outside Japan, targeting projects including similar infrastructure constructions.
